

FHIA Officers' Meeting

All members were present.

1. FH Holiday Party: Secretary will send out an email to all members of the FH community to see if someone is willing to host the party. Michael will forward to me the message that was sent out last year. If unsuccessful with the request, we will consider a post holiday party.
2. "Noise" meeting with Cornell: This is with regard to background noise from buildings. Michael and others met with Steve Beyers and George Taber. Michael will write up a brief summary of the discussions.
