The business portion of the meeting will be followed by a demonstration by Lars Washburn and Katrina Mackey of the radio their grandfather bought in the mid-1930s, recently restored to functionality.

Demonstration of high-end 1930s radio by Lars Washburn and Katrina Mackey.

Lars lives in the house on Judd Falls Road that his grandparents moved into in July 1929. The radio is a McMurdo Masterpiece V. Much more intricate than other radios from this era, it would have been that decade's equivalent of today's high-end home theater setups.

Lars and his sister Katrina will describe the restoration project and Lars will demonstrate the radio from their grandmother's chair in his Forest Home living room, situated as photographed in the 1930s picture below.
